We'll also visit to the **Branson Auto and Farm Museum**, housing an impressive selection of more than a hundred vehicles and an assortment of tractors and implements. Tonight, we'll travel the Clay Cooper Theatre to enjoy a performance by the **Haygoods – Branson's Most Popular Show!** Not your run-of-the-mill family show, these accomplished entertainers—who just happen to be siblings—dazzle audiences with innovative special effects, unsurpassed musicianship demonstrated on more than twenty instruments, sensational singing, and the most fun you've ever had during a live music show!

Friday, October 1 – BRANSON / Camdenton / HANNIBAL

Today we depart Branson and travel north to Camdenton, where we'll tour the **Bridal Cave**, one of America's top show caves.
