Day by Day Itinerary

Mon., Oct. 7 - FAIRFIELD GLADE / EN ROUTE

This morning we depart Fairfield Glade and travel to Nashville International Airport to begin the transatlantic overnight journey to Rome, Italy. (I)

Tues., Oct. 8 – LONDON / SAN GIMIGNANO

As the sun begins to rise on the English coast we arrive in London and continue by connecting flight to Rome, Italy. On arrival, we'll meet our Tour Manager who will accompany us throughout the vacation. Then we're headed north to Tuscany. With its well manicured fields, rustic farms, cypress-lined driveways, and sun and wine-soaked villages clinging to nearly every hill, we'll learn firsthand that Tuscany is the romantic image of Italy. Our destination is San Gimignano, one of the most remarkable of all the Tuscan hill towns. (I,D)

Wed., Oct. 9 – SAN GIMIGNANO (Pisa)

This morning we travel to Pisa, located near the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. A tour through the Campo dei Miracoli will include a visit to the Cattedrale di Pisa. While the white, shining outside of the Cathedral truly is stunning, the same is true of its inside. Next door, we'll visit the Battistero di San Giovanni which was founded on August 15, 1152. Of course, no visit to the Square of Miracles would be complete without a visit to the famous Leaning Tower, as the tower's apparent flouting of the laws of gravity has attracted numerous visitors over the centuries, including the Pisan Scientist Galileo. (B,L)

Thurs., Oct. 10 – SAN GIMIGNANO (Florence)

Julius Caesar founded the colony of Florentia in the 1st century on the north bank of the Arno. Today the city occupies both banks of the Arno River and is famous for its art treasures and glorious history. We begin our tour with a visit to the Galleria dell'Accademia to view Michelangelo's statue of David. Afterward, we'll set out on foot to explore the heart of the city, beginning with a visit to the magnificent Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, and see the neighboring Baptistery of St. John with its famous bronze doors. From here, we'll stroll along the Via dei Calzaiuoli and pause to admire the Piazza della Signoria with its wonderful backdrop formed by the Old Palace's powerful presence, before ending with a visit to the unforgettable Ponte Vecchio, the oldest surviving bridge in the city, built in 1345. As we'll soon find out, walking the streets of Florence is like taking a voyage back in time. **(B,D)**

Fri., Oct. 11 – SAN GIMIGNANO / ROME

This morning we depart San Gimignano and travel to Umbria where we'll stop to visit the spectacular hill town of **Orvieto**, looking down from its cliff edged balcony over the vineyard dotted plains. Here, we leave our motor coach behind and ride the funicular to reach the heart of the town where we'll have an opportunity to browse the shops off the Corso Cavour in the shadow of the Duomo, one of Italy's grandest Romanesque - Gothic cathedrals. Orvieto is also the name of the



surrounding wine region, known primarily for its white Orvieto Classico wine, so be sure to enjoy a glass during our visit. Afterward, we'll be on our way to Rome, the "Eternal City" of the West and capital of the Republic of Italy. As we'll soon learn, Rome rises from both banks of the Tiber River on the slopes of seven hills from where its mighty ruins and superb art have for centuries attracted the world's people. **(B,D)**

Sat., Oct. 12 – ROME (Vatican Museums & St. Peter's) Our day begins with a visit to the Vatican Museums, where four centuries of papal patronage have resulted in one of the world's great collections of art. The Vatican's greatest treasures are its Greek and Roman antiquities highlighted by the Raphael Rooms and the Sistine Chapel featuring the Genesis and Last Judgment by Michelangelo Buonarroti. Afterward, we'll make our way to St. Peter's Square. The embracing arms of Bernini's colonnades will draw us into the Basilica, the center of the Roman Catholic faith. Although you may see hundreds of elaborate and priceless works of art in St. Peter's, none is as moving as the sorrowful Pieta, Michelangelo's masterpiece in white marble. (B,L)

Sun., Oct. 13 – ROME (Monumental Rome)

This morning we visit Rome's monumental sights starting with a visit to the famous Colosseum, where fights between men and beasts, gladiatorial contests, races, and simulated naval battles took place. Next, we're headed to the world-famous Trevi Fountain, Rome's most beloved monument. Toss a coin in the fountain, and you'll ensure your return to the Eternal City! We'll also visit the majestic Pantheon, the most extraordinary and best-preserved ancient building in Rome. Our tour will come to an end in the Piazza Navona, Rome's beautiful Baroque piazza containing three fountains, the most famous of which is Bernini's Fountain of the Four Rivers. No other piazza in Rome can rival the Piazza

Navona, and with its luxurious cafes, this is the perfect spot for an afternoon luncheon. (B,L)

Mon., Oct. 14 – ROME / AMALFI COAST

Today we depart Rome and travel south through the well-tilled fields and orchards of the Lazio countryside en route to the Amalfi Coast. Along the way, we'll stop to visit the ruins at **Pompeii**, the largest of the five towns buried by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius. The scale of the tragedy in Pompeii was appalling; in what had been one of the most active and splendid Roman centers, life came to a permanent standstill. To this day, Pompeii is one of the most visited archaeological sites in the world. Afterward, we'll be on our way to the Amalfi Coast. **(B,L)**



Tues., Oct. 15 – AMALFI COAST (Positano & Amalfi) Today we explore the jewels of the Amalfi Coast by ferry. We'll begin with a visit to **Positano**, perhaps the most famous of the Amalfi coast villages and arguably the most charming. As we'll soon see, the large beach is the focal point of Positano, and enjoys a splendid backdrop of the Chiesa di Santa Maria Assunta, built as if to offer divine protection over the place where the fishermen who inhabited the town used to meet. Then we're headed to Amalfi for an introduction to the town which is primarily centered on the Piazza Duomo and via Lorenzo d'Amalfi. Here, we'll visit the impressive Duomo di Amalfi; its bronze doors, the first to appear in Italy, were fashioned in Constantinople in 1066. Afterward, we'll have an opportunity to wander the Via Genova and Capuano where the varied shop fronts, balconies and flower decked niches lead off the main street into quaint squares. We'll then end our day by learning about the Southern Italian specialty of **limoncello** with a visit and tasting. **(B,L)**

Wed., Oct. 16 – AMALFI COAST (Isle of Capri)

Today we return to the seas and travel by high-speed ferry to the **Isle of Capri**. On arrival in Marina Grande, we'll travel to breathtaking **Anacapri** where our guide will take us through the picturesque lanes and artisan boutiques of the town. Next, we'll set our sights on **Capri**, stopping along the way at the breathtaking Punta di Tragara from where we'll enjoy a scenic view

of the Faraglioni Rocks. Following a brief introduction to the island's main town, free time will be set aside to explore the Piazzetta Umberto, the charming little plaza in the heart of the island. Enjoy a cappuccino at one of the cafes in the shadow of the clock tower and, of course, there is always shopping nearby. As our time on the Isle of Capri nears an end, we'll descend by funicular to **Marina Grande** as we prepare for our return to Sorrento. **(B,D)**

Thurs., Oct. 17 – AMALFI COAST / FAIRFIELD GLADE
This morning we travel to Naples International Airport
in preparation for our return journey home. No better
time to reflect on memories of our vacation to last a
lifetime and celebrate the beginning of new friendships
made along the way! (B,I)
