### **Tour Itinerary**

### Mon., Oct. 14 - CHICAGO / EN ROUTE

Today we depart Chicago's O'Hare International Airport on our non-stop trans-Atlantic flight traveling to Dublin, Ireland. (I)

### Tues., Oct. 15 - DUBLIN / CORK

We arrive in Dublin this morning where we are met by our Irish Driver/Guide who will travel with us throughout our holiday. Our first stop is Guinness Storehouse, where you might like to have some lunch and a pint of the black stuff. On our tour we'll see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today, and finish our visit in the rooftop bar, Gravity, overlooking the city center. This afternoon we depart Dublin and travel south into the plains of Tipperary to the majestic Rock of Cashel. Set on a dramatic outcrop of limestone in the Golden Vale, the Rock of Cashel, iconic in its historic significance, possesses the most impressive cluster of medieval buildings in Ireland. We'll continue on to the city of Cork where we'll enjoy dinner at our hotel. (I,D)

### Wed., Oct. 16 - CORK

We begin with a short drive to Cobh for a visit to Cobh Heritage Centre, which depicts the varied history of emigration from Ireland and many European countries to the United States over the past 150 years. Cobh was the last port of call for the "Titanic" and many liners that carried emigrants to the New World. Next, we tour the Old Midleton Distillery, home to the world-renowned Jameson Irish Whiskey. At the end of your tour, enjoy a sampling of the finished product. This afternoon we make our way to Ballymaloe, where we explore the world of Irish Cooking, with a cooking demonstration and tastings of the final product. (B,S)

### Thurs., Oct. 17 - CORK

Following breakfast we hear the story of Cork: its history, its people, colorful culture, wit and special traditions. Our local guide will take us on a tour of Cork where we will experience the scents and sounds of the English Market, stroll the busy lanes of the 18th century Huguenot Quarter and wonder at the magnificent French neo-gothic cathedral. This afternoon we'll journey to the seaside town of Kinsale, Ireland's foodie capital. We'll get to know Kinsale on a relaxed but highly focused food stroll with an engaging and experienced guide. We'll go to places that are off the usual food route where tastings are generous and the people lively. Cork people are enormously proud of their food and quite rightly! (B,FT)

### Fri., Oct. 18 - CORK / TRALEE

This morning we visit Blarney to climb the battlements of Blarney Castle and kiss the famous Blarney Stone. It is said when you kiss the Stone, you gain the gifts of eloquence, wit and wisdom. We will also have time to visit the Blarney Woolen Mills, which has an excellent range of Irish products of all types. From Blarney we drive over the mountains and into the Kingdom of Kerry to Killarney National Park, Ireland's oldest national park. We will experience the park in the traditional way, by horse and carriage, which is known locally as a "Killarney jaunting car." We'll enjoy the scenic route around the Muckross Park Estate to the historic Muckross Abbey. After free time to explore Killarney, we'll continue to Tralee and our hotel for the next two nights. (B,D)

### Sat., Oct. 19 – TRALEE (Dingle Peninsula)

Today we explore the Dingle Peninsula on Ireland's Wild Atlantic Way, the westernmost part of Ireland that juts out



into the Atlantic and contains some of the most ancient and traditional aspects of Irish culture. We'll have time to enjoy the thriving fishing port of Dingle - be sure to try the chowder that County Kerry is famous for! We return to Tralee where the remainder of the day is free for individual pursuits. Dine in one of the many pubs and restaurants and you may like to find a "singing bar" for traditional Irish entertainment. **(B)** 

### Sun., Oct. 20 – TRALEE / BUNRATTY

Today we bid farewell to the Kingdom of Kerry and we're off to board the ferry at Killimer which takes us to the Banner County of Clare. Our first stop will be the Cliffs of Moher to enjoy spectacular views. Even when shrouded in mist or buffeted by gales, the Cliffs of Moher are a breath-taking sight as they rise to a height of 650 feet from out of the Atlantic. Afterwards we'll make a stop at Gus O'Connor's Pub in Doolin for the best fish and chips in the world, before continuing to nearby Bunratty and our hotel for overnight. Tonight we'll join the Earl of Thomond for a glorious banquet at the majestic 15th century Bunratty Castle and more than likely stop for a drink in Durty Nelly's, one of Ireland's most iconic pubs. ### Mon., Oct. 21 – BUNRATTY / KILKENNY

This morning we follow the banks of the Shannon River to the city of Limerick where we visit King Johns Castle. Striking an imposing figure along the banks of the River Shannon and dominating the town of Limerick, this 12th Century castle was built by King John of England and stands as a testament to 800 years of history. Next we visit the village of Adare. Billed as Ireland's prettiest village, we'll have an opportunity to stroll along the town's Main Street of thatched houses, colorfully painted storefronts and beautiful gardens. Our day will come to an end on our arrival in town of Kilkenny, one of Ireland's loveliest medieval cities. (B,D)

### Tues., Oct. 22 – KILKENNY

An introduction to Kilkenny today will take us past the Dominican Black Abbey and St. Canice's hilltop cathedral before reaching Parliament Street, home to the Rothe House, a unique Irish merchant's townhouse. We'll then travel along High Street dominated by the 18th century Tholsel, with its distinctive clock tower and arcade, before stopping to visit the magnificently restored Kilkenny Castle. After the castle, we'll enjoy a tour and tasting at Smithwicks Brewery, for which Kilkenny is famous. Kilkenny is famous for many charming pubs; Kytlers Inn, The Marble City Bar, Lanigan's and Matt the Miller – just to mention a few – and it's Shay's intention to sink a pint in most of them, and enjoy fine Irish music. (B)

### Wed., Oct. 23 - KILKENNY / DUBLIN

Our day begins with a drive into the Wicklow Mountains on our way to Glendalough. "The glen of the two lakes" is a truly spellbinding place; an ancient monastic settlement and two clear water lakes beneath the sheer cliffs of a deep valley, and a center

for pilgrims and visitors since its foundation by St. Kevin in the 6th century. We continue through the Wicklow Mountains to Powerscourt House and Gardens, a magnificent estate boasting 47 acres of gardens, where we'll enjoy a walk in the gardens, and have time to visit the Powerscourt shops. We also visit the Powerscourt Distillery. Our day comes to an end in Dublin. We will end our stay on the Emerald Isle in style at the Merry Ploughboy Pub for our farewell dinner and show featuring traditional Irish music and dance. (B,D)

### Thurs., Oct. 24 – DUBLIN / CHICAGO

All too soon, our vacation in Ireland has come to the end. Transfer to Dublin Airport in plenty of time to check in for your flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your flight returning us to Chicago. **(B,I)**
