Mon., Sept. 16 - MILWAUKEE / EN ROUTE

Today we depart Moran's Pub by motor coach for the drive to Chicago's O'Hare International Airport. Here we board our non-stop trans-Atlantic flight traveling to Dublin, Ireland. (I)

Tues., Sept. 17 - DUBLIN / SLIGO

We arrive in Dublin this morning. Here we are met by our Irish Driver/Guide who will travel with us throughout the Irish Adventure. We depart Dublin Airport our first stop is the World Heritage Site of Brú na Bóinne, famous for the spectacular prehistoric passage tomb of Newgrange, which dates back to 3200 BC. Following our visit we continue to the wild Atlantic way and the town of Sligo. Dinner is included this evening at our hotel. (I,D)

Wed., Sept. 18 - SLIGO

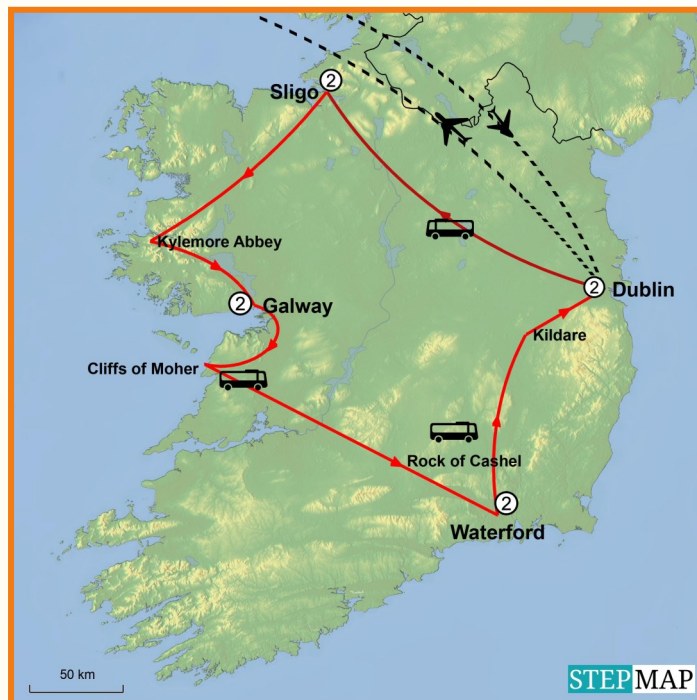
We begin with a great day in Sligo, with a couple of options for you to experience. You will have time to explore wonderful Sligo with its shops and delightful cafes. If you wish we will have a hike on Queen Maeve's Trail up the mountain of Knocknarea. In Irish mythology Knocknarea is the burial place of the beautiful Warrior Queen Maeve of Connaught. Or if you prefer we will have an **option** to play a round of golf at Strandhill Golf Club overlooking the North Atlantic or will be made available. This evening we visit a local pub for a Gaelic cultural experience. (B)

Thurs., Sept. 19 - SLIGO / GALWAY

Today we depart Sligo and explore the rugged yet serene Connemara region. This rocky land of broad-backed mountains and pearl like lakes is the largest Irish speaking section of the country and the old traditional ways of life are as much a part of this regions attraction as is the scenery. We visit picturesque Kylemore Abbey, a castellated neo-Gothic mansion now occupied by an Irish Benedictine community of nuns. After our visit to Kylemore Abbey, we continue through the amazing countryside to Galway. Dinner is included this evening at our hotel. (B,D)

Fri., Sept. 20 - GALWAY

After breakfast we'll join Galway guide Brian Nolan for



a walking tour of the city, a truly entertaining and engaging way to see and experience the history and culture of Galway. Afterward, we're free in Galway to enjoy the music, charm and banter of the local characters as you shop and explore the city. Or if you prefer there will be an **optional** full-day excursion to the Aran Islands. (B)

Sat., Sept. 21 - GALWAY / WATERFORD

An amazing day is in store as we drive to the Atlantic Coast to view the majestic Cliffs of Moher, a rocky wall that rises nearly 700 feet above the foaming Atlantic Ocean. This afternoon we depart the Cliffs of Moher and drive east passing the town of Limerick and through the Tipperary Plain. We will make a photo stop at the majestic Rock of Cashel, that is set on a dramatic outcrop of limestone in the Golden Vale. We will arrive in Waterford, sitting in the heart of Ireland's ancient southeast. Waterford is Ireland's oldest city and is a treasure-trove of ancient artefacts, elegant architecture, great local food and of course crystal. Dinner is included at our hotel this evening. (B,D)



Sun., Sept. 22 - WATERFORD

We begin today with stroll around the streets of this historic city. Our local guide will show us Waterford's Viking and Medieval past. This afternoon, we visit the House of Waterford Crystal where we see skilled artisans create magnificent crystal masterpieces. (B)

Mon., Sept. 23 - WATERFORD / DUBLIN

This morning we leave Waterford and make our way north towards Dublin. Our first visit of the day is at a local farm in the village of Ballybaught where we see sheepdogs at work. A wonderful location where we will experience a taste of pastoral life. In this relaxed atmosphere, the hard working sheepdogs will leave you feeling enchanted. See if you can whistle and command the dogs or simply sit back, relax and enjoy as Michael and his sheepdogs do their work with the sheep. Our next visit is to the home of equine royalty, the Irish National Stud. Established in 1946, the "National Stud" combines an active role in the development and promotion of Irish thoroughbred bloodstock. A tour of the grounds will allow us to see the next champions as they are being exercised, as well as explore the special foaling unit, and the farms forge and saddlery, before stopping at the Horse Museum. Late this afternoon we arrive in the city of Dublin. (B)

Tues., Sept. 24 - DUBLIN

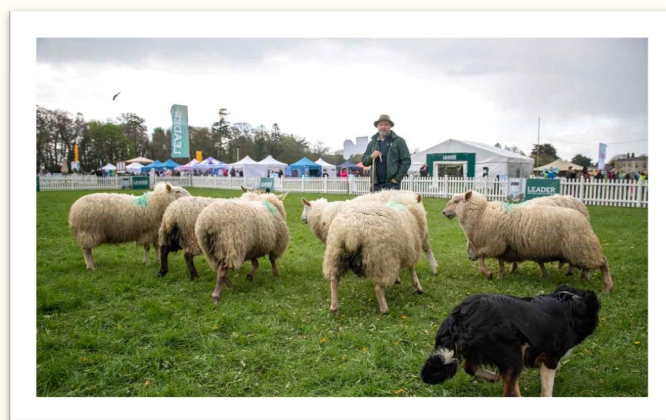
This morning we'll pick up our local guide for an introductory tour of Dublin and see the prominent historic buildings and monuments. In the Georgian Era, Dublin was considered the Second City of the British Empire. Then we'll head to the heart of Dublin to The Guinness Storehouse, where you might like to have some lunch and a pint of the black stuff. On our tour we'll see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today, and finish our visit in the rooftop bar, Gravity, overlooking the city center. This afternoon we visit Pearse Lyons Distillery, built in the beautifully restored Church of St. James in Dublin's historic Liberties, where we'll enjoy a tour and whiskey tasting. Afterward, we'll have time to explore Grafton Street before we return to our hotel and prepare for tonight's Hooley at the Irish House Party - a

night full of traditional Irish music, dancing and entertainment! (B,D)

Wed., Sept. 25 - DUBLIN / CHICAGO / MILWAUKEE

All too soon, our *Irish Adventure* tour comes to an end as we head to Dublin Airport for the journey home. No better time to reflect on memories that will last a lifetime and new friendships made along the way! On arrival in Chicago our motorcoach will return us to South Milwaukee. (B,I)

Trip cancellation & trip interruption
