

Day by Day Itinerary

Mon., Sept. 23 - DUNDEE / EN ROUTE

Our Pilgrimage to Ireland begins as we transfer from Dundee to Chicago's O'Hare International Airport to board our over- night non-stop flight to Dublin. (I)

Tues., Sept. 24 – DUBLIN

We arrive in Dublin this morning where we are met by our Irish Tour Manager, who will accompany us on our Pilgrimage. We begin with Mass before departing the airport then we are off to the Boyne Valley where we visit the Hill of Tara, the seat of the High Kings of Ireland. St. Patrick is said to have come to Tara to confront the ancient pagan religion. Next, we visit the Hill of Slane, where in 433, in defiance of the pagan High King Laoire, Patrick lit a Paschal fire. Though angry, Laoire was so impressed by Patrick's devotion he allowed him to continue his missionary work. Next, we visit the Kells monastic site, including the Kells Round Tower, associated with St. Colmcille (also known as Columba) and the Book of Kells. We'll enjoy dinner at our Dublin hotel this evening. (I,D)

Wed., Sept. 25 – DUBLIN (Downpatrick)

Today we travel to Downpatrick and visit the Down Cathedral, the reputed burial place of St. Patrick, which is marked by a granite boulder. We will celebrate Mass in Downpatrick. We will also visit the St. Patrick Center, where we learn about Ireland's Patron Saint and the importance of early monastic life. **(B)**

Thurs., Sept. 26 – DUBLIN / WESTPORT

This morning we will depart Dublin and drive into the heart of county Mayo to the pilgrimage town of Knock. Here we visit Knock Shrine, one of the world's leading shrines, where the Virgin Mary appeared to 15 people on August 21, 1879. We will see the shrine and modern Basilica and celebrate Mass. This afternoon we will continue to the beautiful town of Westport and our hotel. **(B,D)**

Fri., Sept. 27 – WESTPORT (Connemara)

Today we explore the rugged yet serene Connemara region. This rocky land of broad-backed mountains and pearl-like lakes is the largest Irish-speaking section of the country. The old traditional ways of life are as much a part of this region's attraction as is the scenery. We are headed to picturesque Kylemore Abbey. Nestled in the heart of Connemara, Kylemore Abbey is a haven of history, beauty. and serenity and is home to a Benedictine order of Nuns for the past 100 years. We will explore the house and gardens and celebrate Mass. Next, we make our way



to Croagh Patrick, soaring to a height of 765 meters. The mountain overlooks Clew Bay and the entire western coastline. It is here at Croagh Patrick that, according to traditions and accounts, in 441 AD St. Patrick spent the 40 days of Lent praying and fasting on the mountain top as part of his effort to convert Ireland to Christianity. **(B)**

Sat., Sept. 28 – WESTPORT / KILLARNEY

We depart Westport and make our way south through the Burren, a vast limestone plateau occupying an area of over one hundred square miles in northwest County Clare. We will arrive at the Cliffs of Moher to enjoy spectacular views. Even when shrouded in mist or buffeted by gales, the Cliffs of Moher are a breath-taking sight as they rise to a height of 700 feet from out of the Atlantic. Afterward, we will take a short ferry ride across the River Shannon to the mountainous countryside of the Kingdom of Kerry. We continue to the delightful town of Killarney, where on arrival we will celebrate Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral. **(B,D)**

Sun., Sept. 29 – KILLARNEY (Ring of Kerry)

Today we discover the wonderful scenery of Killarney as we sit back and enjoy a drive around the famous Ring of Kerry. The road winds between the Macgillycuddy's Reeks, Ireland's highest mountains, and the Atlantic coast. We will celebrate Mass along the way. On our return to



Killarney, the afternoon is at leisure to enjoy the shops and local characters, or perhaps stroll through the splendid Muckross House and Gardens. (B)

Mon., Sept. 30 - KILLARNEY / DUBLIN

We depart Killarney this morning and journey to Tubrid Holy Well. In the month of May each year vast numbers of people travel to the holy well of Tubrid to "do the rounds." People come now to pray the rosary and drink the healing waters. We will celebrate Mass on our way to visit Blarney Castle, a medieval stronghold in County Cork. The Blarney Stone is a block of bluestone built into the battlements of Blarney Castle and according to legend, kissing the stone endows one with the gift of gab (great eloquence or skill at flattery!). We will continue to Dublin, stopping along the way for a photo opportunity of the Rock of Cashel. **(B)**

Tues., Oct. 1 – DUBLIN (Glendalough and Powerscourt) Today we set out for a fabulous day in the Garden of Ireland, County Wicklow. Our first stop takes us through the Wicklow Mountains on our way to Glendalough. "The Glen of the Two Lakes" is a truly spellbinding place; an ancient monastic settlement with two clear water lakes beneath the sheer cliffs of a deep valley carved out by glaciers during the Ice Age. The monastic settlement has been a center for pilgrims and visitors since its foundation by St. Kevin in the 6th century. We will celebrate Mass before departing Glendalough. We'll head back north to the Powerscourt Distillery for a tour and whiskey tasting before a visit to Powerscourt House and Gardens, a magnificent estate boasting 47 acres of gar- dens. We'll enjoy a walk in the gardens and have time to visit the Powerscourt shops. We'll end our day with an Irish Hooley, a night full of traditional Irish music, dancing and entertainment! (B,D)

Wed., Oct. 2 – DUBLIN

This morning we will begin with Mass before embarking on a Dublin city sightseeing tour of this famous city on the River Liffey. Points of interest include the Bank of Ireland built in 1729, formerly the Irish Parliament; the National Museum; Dublin Castle; and Four Courts built in the 18th century and now housing the High Courts of Justice. We will visit Trinity College which houses the famous Book of Kells, transcribed by 9th century monks, then Christ Church Cathedral, the elder of the city's two medieval cathedrals. Our tour comes to an end at the Guinness Store House where we learn about the brewing process while enjoying a fabulous view of Dublin. This afternoon is at leisure for shopping along Dublin's famous Grafton

Street, or to simply enjoy this very cosmopolitan capital city. This evening we have one more dinner in Ireland to reflect on our Pilgrimage. (B,D)

Thurs., Oct. 3 – DUBLIN / CHICAGO

This morning we will transfer to Dublin Airport for our return non-stop flight to Chicago. On arrival at Chicago O'Hare International Airport our motor coach will be waiting to return us to Dundee. (B,I)
