Day By Day Itinerary

Mon., Sept. 1 – CHICAGO / EN ROUTE

We will depart Chicago's O'Hare International Airport this evening by scheduled service of Lufthansa German Airlines on the overnight transatlantic flight to Munich, Germany. (I)

Tues., Sept. 2 – MUNICH / SEEFELD

On arrival in Munich we meet our Tour Manager who will accompany us throughout the vacation. Leaving Munich Airport we'll travel by autobahn south across the Austrian border to the Alpine resort of Seefeld, located on a sunny plateau above the Inn River Valley amidst the grandeur of the imposing Karwendel and Wetterstein mountain ranges. As you'll soon find out, Seefeld is one of the most charming towns in Tyrol. With its compact town center, artistic homes, casino, restaurants and shopping options, few resorts can match its unique modern amenities and traditional charm. (I,D)

Wed., Sept. 3 – SEEFELD

(Achensee Railway and Cruise & Wattens) A leisurely day on tour will take us to the village of Jenbach where we'll board the Achensee Steam Cog Railway. Sit back, relax and take in the scenery as this highly nostalgic and romantic experience will take us along lush meadows and through Alpine forests with impressive views of the Tyrolean Alps. On arrival in the village of Seespitz, we'll embark on a Cruise of the Achensee, often called the "Fjord of the Alps." We'll disembark in Pertisau, once the private summer retreat of the Austrian Emperors, where free time will be set aside for a bite to eat and shopping along the lakeside promenade. On our return to Seefeld we'll stop in the market town of Wattens for a visit to Swarovski's Kristallwelten, truly fantastic journey that will take us past works in crystal by world-renowned artists and into the six "chambers of Wonders." (B)

<u>Thurs., Sept. 4 – SEEFELD (Fairytale Bavaria)</u>

Today we travel to the forests, meadows and peat bogs whose gentle undulations characterize the final slopes of the Ammergau Alps. Here we'll visit Linderhof Palace, perhaps the most interesting of the castles built towards the end of the 19th century by "Mad" King Ludwig II of Bavaria. Our next stop will take us to Oberammergau, nestled in a wonderful landscape in the Ammergau Alps. Oberammergau is known not only for its Passion Play, but also for its wood carvings and

the so-called Luftlmalerei, the paintings that decorate many of the walls of the old houses. We'll set aside time to wander the quaint downtown, an opportunity to visit the baroque Parish Church, to view the beautifully painted homes, many in fairytale design depicting scenes from Little Red Riding Hood and Hansel and Gretel. On the return to Seefeld, we'll stop to visit the Benedictine **Ettal Abbey** where the monks have been preparing special liqueurs for centuries. A visit will reveal the magnificent Rococo vestry and treasures in the monastery library that attract thousands of visitors each year. **(B)**

<u>Fri., Sept. 5 – Fri., Sept. 5 – SEEFELD / Bolzano / TREVISO</u>

This morning we say "tschüss" to Seefeld and Austria as we travel south over the magnificent Brenner Pass and the Italian border to visit the city of Bolzano, the capital of Trentino Alto Adige. Bolzano's medieval city center, Gothic and Romanesque churches, and bilingual signage give it the flavor of a city at the crossroads of Austrian and Italian cultures. This afternoon we set our sights on <u>Treviso</u>, (the birthplace of Tiramisu) Treviso is ideal for discovering the artistic and natural beauty of the Veneto region **(B,D)**

Sat., Sept. 6 –TREVISO (Venice)

Today we journey to Venice. As we'll soon find out, Venice is singular among the world's cities, situated on a broad lagoon and built over a sprawling archipelago of little islands separated by more than 150 canals and 400 bridges. We'll see the Statue of Vittorio Emanuele II, the first king of a united Italy, and pass by the Hotel Danieli, a 19th century haunt for writers and artists alike, before reaching the Ponte della Paglia. Also known as the "Straw Bridge," it is here where we'll find the best views of the neighboring Bridge of Sighs. Our walking tour will continue into the Piazza San Marco, a great marble saloon with covered galleries, famous cafes, and luxury shops. Here we'll see the Campanile, a 325-foot-high tower that provides an unforgettable view of Venice, and the remarkable Basilica San Marco. (B,D)

Sun., Sept. 7 – Treviso / Bergamo / STRESA This morning we will depart Ponzano and travel across the

Plains of Lombardy to visit the delightful hilltop village of Bergamo. Although the town is divided into two distinct parts, Bergamo Alta crowning the hill and airy Bergamo Bassa lying below, we'll spend our time in Bergamo Alta. Surrounded by 16th century Venetian walls, the Piazza Vecchia is home to one of the most appealing architectural collections in the region. We'll see the 12th century Torre del Comune, 16th century Biblioteca Civica, and the attractive 12th century Palazzo della Ragione, the oldest town hall in Italy, adorned with a statue of the lion of Venice. Following our visit, we'll continue our journey to the western shore of Lake Maggiore and the Italian Lake District resort of Stresa. Its beautiful countryside, architectural gems and mild climate combine to make Stresa one of the most popular destinations in the Piedmont region. (B,D)

Mon., Sept.8 – STRESA (Isola Bella)

The Borromean Islands, lying at the center of Lake Maggiore, are small jewels of natural beauty augmented by artificial grottoes, architectural follies, and landscaped parks. A relaxing day in Stresa will begin with a trip by motor launch to the legendary Borromean Island of Isola Bella, where we'll visit the Palazzo Borromeo, the epitome of opulence and luxury. Afterward, we'll return to Stresa, or you may prefer to venture off to Isola dei Pescatori and Isola Madre. Despite the Alpine setting, the islands share a pleasant climate, but each offers a very different experience. The afternoon is free in Stresa to explore the picturesque Old Town with its maze of narrow streets, or to simply stroll along the splendid flower-decked lake promenade and enjoy one of Italy's most beautiful lake and mountain views. (B)

Tues., Sept.9 – STRESA / Gotthard Pass / LUCERNE

This morning we depart Stresa and say "arrivederci" to Italy as we travel across the Swiss border - and weather permitting - ascend the magnificent St. Gotthard Pass, often referred to as the "King of Mountain Passes". This majestic Alpine crossing forms a weather, water and cultural divide between north and south and has fascinated those passing through for centuries. We'll stop for lunch high atop the Gotthard Pass before descending into central Switzerland on our way to the sparkling blue shores of Lake Lucerne, unquestionably one of Europe's most charming destinations with stunning lake and mountain scenery. Our destination is the city of Lucerne, the gateway to central Switzerland, ideally situated in the historic and scenic heart of what many believe to be the 'true' Switzerland. (B,D)

walk along the Reuss River past the Jesuits' Church to the Spreuer Bridge, whose painted gables portray the "Dance of Death" commemorating a plague outbreak in the 17th century. Next, we'll stroll across the famous Chapel Bridge adorned with paintings that depict the history of Lucerne and Switzerland. From here our walking tour continues into Altstadt with its charming houses, painted facades and flower-decked fountains. We'll pause in the Weinmarkt and take in Hirschenplatz Square, Lucerne's Town Hall and the painted Pfistern guildhall on Kornmarkt Square.

Following our tour, free time will be set aside to explore Lucerne on our own. Enjoy a walk along the lakeside promenade between the Schweizerhofquai and Nationalquai for views of Mount Pilatus, and view the Lion Monument, hewn out of natural rock in memory of the Swiss Guard. **(B)**

Thurs., Sept. 11 – LUCERNE (Mt. Pilatus)

Another leisurely day on tour begins with a **Cruise on the Vierwaldstättersee** to Alpnachstad from here we board the **Pilatus Railway**, the steepest rack railway in the world, to the summit of Mount Pilatus. On a clear day you can see beyond Switzerland to Austria, France, Germany, Italy and Liechtenstein. Our descent will take us on an exciting aerial cableway and panoramic gondola down to the village of Kriens. This evening, we'll end our vacation in grand style with an evening of singing, dancing, yodeling and other fun activities.

Fri., Sept. 12 – LUCERNE / Zurich / CHICAGO

This morning we will say "auf wiedersehen" to Lucerne and travel to Zurich Airport in preparation for our journey home. No better time to reflect on memories of our vacation to last a lifetime and celebrate the beginning of new friendships made along the way!
